

AO CMF Advanced Course— Craniofacial surgery focusing on Distraction Osteogenesis

March 16-18, 2023

Lisbon, Portugal

Course description

This 2.5 day course features dry bones practical exercises in a two-participant sharing workstation basis. Computer virtual surgery planning practical interactive session will be simulated with a clinical engineer and a faculty. Expert faculties will share their tips and tricks in short lectures focusing on the most important distraction topics. They will guide case-based interactive small group discussions used to elaborate on the core content introduced through lectures. Discussions will be held throughout the course to link the lecture material and practical skills taught with the problems encountered by the course participants in their individual practice.

The course is aimed at experienced trainees, early career surgeons and experienced surgeons in Oral Maxillofacial, Plastics or ENT, wishing to advance their knowledge of distraction osteogenesis and cranio-facial reconstruction.
